

Moto Trax / Explorer Frequently Asked Questions

How do I license my Explorer?

For licensing in the state of Washington, just go to any Washington vehicle licensing office. Be sure to take your title and current registration. Also, print out a brochure from this website showing the Explorer kit.

At the licensing office explain that you have added a commercially available kit to convert your motorcycle to a snowmobile for winter use. Show the brochure and point out that your vehicle with the kit meets the definition of a snowmobile because it is driven by a continuous track and steered with a ski. Tell them you want to apply for **DUAL REGISTRATION** for this vehicle. It does not matter if your original registration is for highway or off highway use. In either case you simply want to **ADD** use as a snowmobile Washington state.

At this point there is a good chance they will tell you this is not possible. This is a new concept and most offices have not been through the process. Politely assure them that there is a process for this and ask them to call their contact in Olympia. The Olympia office should walk them through the steps. The dual registration will cost you about \$70 the first time.

If you are not able to get through the process, call the Washington State Liaison office at 360 902 3748 and explain your dilemma while you are still at the licensing office. They will call the licensing office where you are having trouble and help you.

Notes:

1. You should receive a snow-park, parking sticker which must be displayed in your vehicle at the snow-park.
2. It is best to go to the licensing office on a weekday to be sure there will be someone to answer the call in Olympia!! Be patient. This is going to take a little time until it becomes more routine.
